

Redemption® Tournament Host Instructions

Last Updated 10/30/2019

Confirm that the packet you just received contains the following:

- Address sheets
- 3 (8 x 10) posters
- Prizes for winners
- Special promotional tournament cards
- A postage-paid envelope to return un-issued cards, players addresses, and winners.
- A winner sheet

At the beginning of your tournament you will need to register all players. Have each player PRINT (clearly) his/her address on the enclosed address sheets. As each player does so, they are given a promotional Redemption card. Each player then needs to sign on the line under his/her address to verify that the promo card has been received. (PLEASE NOTE: for state, regional and national tournaments, participants will receive one of each card provided).

During the tournament, record the winners of each category(s) on the winner sheet, and distribute prizes (listed below).

After the tournament, place the remaining promotional cards (we expect all remaining cards to be returned), un-issued prizes, the address sheets, and winner sheet in the postage paid envelope and send them back to us. PLEASE NOTE: If additional postage is required (due to extra prizes from canceled categories), the extra postage is the responsibility of the tournament host. Also, Canadian hosts are responsible for all return postage.

WARNING: It is very important that these things be sent back to Cactus Game Design immediately following the tournament. RNRS points will not be awarded until these items are returned. If you return these items later than five weeks after your tournament, you might lose the privilege to host future Redemption tournaments.
